Browser Compatibility

This release will address the browser compatibility issue with Mariner PPM that restrict users to Version 8 of IE. This release will enable users to use PPM on the latest release of Internet Explorer 11 providing support for HTML/HTML5/XHTML.

As part of our ongoing product development program Mariner PPM will be updated to work on future browser versions. Browser compatibility updates will be addressed at the time of each major browser release. Q1 release will focus on Internet Explorer.

Java Compatibility

One of the issues that is being reported by clients is that the task plan does not always load properly. This is caused by incompatibility between the client PC and the versions of the Java Runtime Environment. This release will address this compatibility issue, ensuring that the task plan will work with latest versions of Java Runtime Environment.
